Please follow the instructions below to commit to sponsorship. The NSBE fiscal year is from May 1 to July 31. Benefits are generally applicable during this period of time.

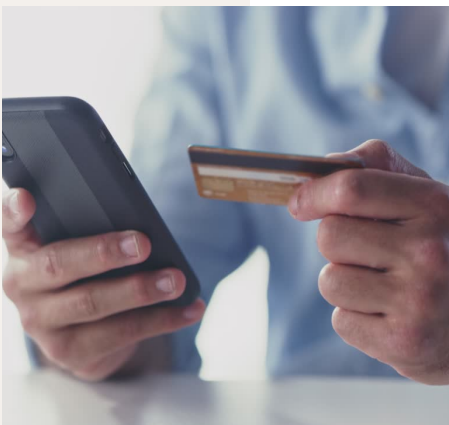

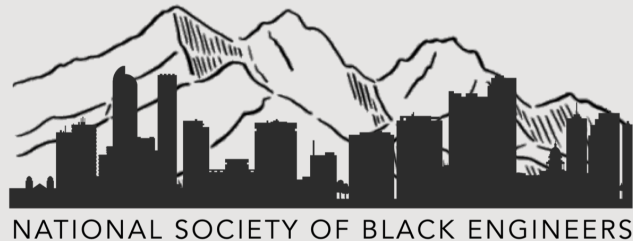
